Step 3: Follow the onscreen sign in prompts and you're in!


Just be sure the email address you sign in with matches the email address you registered with us otherwise we won't know it's you.



4. Enter your name and, instead of requesting a new Google email address, click on 'use my current email address instead' and enter the email address you registered with us.


